

# Forest Guild Internship: Summer 2008

## Description of Internship:

The Forest Guild is seeking a graduate level student to work on forest related issues in New Mexico. The internship is based out of our Santa Fe office and will assist Forest Guild staff in a variety of ongoing community forestry, biomass and youth training initiatives. The candidate will be expected to travel to project sites and communities throughout the state, and assist staff with ecological and socio-economic monitoring, trainings, youth education, and general field work. There will be additional opportunities to work on the Guild's biomass case study research project and explore the relationship between wildfire and low-capacity communities.

## Organization Description

The Forest Guild, a national organization of foresters and allied natural resource professionals, is dedicated to promoting excellent forestry. The Guild has over 500 members, over half of whom are professionals who manage, collectively, 42 million acres of forest land in the United States and Canada. These members include foresters who work for small and medium-size companies, state land managers who oversee forest operations on large ownerships, foresters who manage lands for investment companies and consulting professionals who advise and assist private landowners. The Guild's National Office and the Southwest Regional Office are located in Santa Fe, NM. The Guild maintains regional offices in Massachusetts and California.

## Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have experience with forestry and/or ecology-based field work, excellent data collection and communication skills, and interest in learning and working with New Mexico's Native American and traditional Hispano peoples.

## Compensation:

Forest Guild interns are hired as temporary employees and are paid biweekly. All work-related travel and expenses will be covered by the Forest Guild. Interns are responsible for lodging and travel to and from Santa Fe.
