Awards will be presented May 17, 2012 during the Awards banquet at the Thirty-Sixth Annual National Indian Timber Symposium in Warm Springs, OR.

Nominations can be made by anyone, not just supervisors or upper level management. Tribal leaders and Tribal Councils are encouraged to make nominations. Make sure your nominations, with supporting documentation, are in our office by the close of business (5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time) January 27, 2012.

Nominations must be received by the Intertribal Timber Council office by the close of business (5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time) January 27, 2012. Incomplete applications or applications received after that date will not be considered.
